What image quality is required?

When uploading your logo, in order to get the best results we require a logo that is 300 DPI in either a PNG, SVG, JPG or JPEG format. If an image has a resolution of 300 DPI, it means that every inch contains 300 dots of ink, therefore increasing the quality of the image.

Why does my logo appear with a box around it?

Please note logos uploaded that are not transparent will appear with a white box around them. This will not be included in the final design of the beanie unless specified otherwise.

Unsure of logo quality?

If you are unsure about whether your logo is 300 DPI or not, upload the largest version of the logo possible, as every pixel makes a difference. The more pixels in the image, the better. If the logo still isn't suitable, a member of the Cheeta team will be in contact to help you out. Please note there may be a small fee for logos under 300 DPI.

What is a sublimated badge?

In some instances, embroidery cannot always capture every detail of a logo, so a sublimated badge is required. Sublimated badges are logos that are printed onto a badge and then sewn onto the beanie. This branding method is the best option for logos that are more complicated or have gradient patterns. One of our Account Managers will contact you if adjustments to your logo need to be made.
